WHO'S AT RISK??

If you're a woman, you're at risk for **gynecologic cancer**. The 5 main types are cervical, ovarian, uterine, vaginal and vulvar.

According to the American Cancer Society an estimated 98,000 cases will be diagnosed in 2015, and more than 30,000 women will die from gynecologic cancer.
